Silicon Valley Engineering Council Engineering Education Awards

By submission of the SVEC Scholarship application, applicant declares that:

- A) The applicant is a full- or part- time student.
- B) The applicant is graduating High School this year OR
- C) The applicant will be/continue to be enrolled as an undergraduate at a College or University in an Engineering, Science or Mathematics program in 2010.
- D) The applicant is a resident (or student of a College or University) in the area served by the Silicon Valley Engineering Council; SVEC serves the area centered in the Santa Clara Valley and roughly bounded on the North by CA 92 and roughly bounded on the South by CA152. In the area served by the SVEC are cities such as:

- B) The completed, legible application form
- C) The official transcript OR unofficial (photocopied) transcript
- D) Essay, typed/printed, signed and dated by the applicant.
- E) List of Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics Courses
- F) Letter(s) of recommendation (2)
- G) List of experiences in employment or service related to engineering (if any)
- H) List of offices you have held in engineering societies (if any)
- I) List of engineering/science/technology projects in which you have participated (if any)
- J) List of volunteer or service work you have done at your school or in your community (if any)
- K) A postmark no later than February 5, 2010 (E-mailed or late submissions will be rejected)

Awards Eligibility and Criteria

The Silicon Valley Engineering Council Engineering Education awards recognize young engineering and technology students for their dedication, focus, and commitment to engineering. Engineering and Technology students graduating from high school, or presently enrolled in undergraduate community college and university programs are eligible to apply. Fulltime and part-time students are eligible. Students may receive an SVEC Scholarship award only once. Graduate students are not eligible.

The selection of awardees under this program will be based on the following factors. Keep these factors in mind while completing this application.

Not all of these must be met by a successful applicant:

- *The applicant's program of study is directly focused on engineering or technology*
- *The applicant has shown involvement in professional and/or student activities (i.e. engineering societies)*
- *The applicant has shown involvement in community and/or social services activities*
- *The applicant has two letters of recommendations from faculty members*
- *The student exhibits strong academic performance as shown by GPA in the major and overall, as well as strong recommendations from faculty advisors*
- *A brief essay describing the student's academic and professional goals is submitted for evaluation*
